MOUNTAINS IN THE SUN 10 DAYS

This tour explores Ecuador's capital Quito: cathedrals, museums, the government plaza with its layers of indigenous and colonial history, then moves to the city of Cuenca, a World Cultural Heritage site and a centerpiece of Spanish colonial architecture. We return through the capital to tour the High Sierra staying for four nights in a restored 1602 hacienda with daily visits to Otavalo markets, the pristine volcanic lakes, leather village and much more. THE HIGH SIERRA TOUR 8 DAYS

Our tour begins in Quito, Ecuador's capital, at 9,200 ft. in the Andes. After a morning city tour, we travel to Las Palmeras Inn for three nights, then the renowned Hacienda Cusin for the rest of the week in the spectacular High Sierra landscape visited by Frederick Church of Hudson River School fame. Experience life in the middle of the world! Day trips explore villages, volcanic lakes, waterfalls and the homes & schools of families weaving, hat making, wood carving. TEXTILES & TREASURES 12 DAYS

Peruvian Inca ruins were discovered by Hiram Bingham in the early 1900's. Now, there is a wealth of sites around the Inca capital of Cuzco. We explore many of them including Machu Picchu, Ollantaytambo and Pisac. We visit the weaving collective in Chinceros, explore the monumental colonial churches and buildings amidst the spectacular Sacred Valley carved by the rushing Urubamba River. Each night we relax in beautiful accommodations, just off the beaten pathway. Begin in Lima. Exact dates to be announced - March, 2013 \$2600 per person + air
